## **Stud Muesli Composition**

Oats, Dehulled soya bean meal, Extracted sunflower, Oatfeed, Cane molasses, Alfalfa, Wheatfeed, Full fat soya, Barley, Unmolassed sugar beet, Distillers' wheat grains, Maize, Peas, Calcium carbonate, Full fat linseed, Monocalcium phosphate, Rapeseed oil, Sodium chloride, Sodium bicarbonate, Magnesium oxide, Fructose oligosaccharides, Mannan oligosaccharides

## **Feeding Rate**

Mares (early pregnancy) and stallions (light work): feed 500-700g/100kg bodyweight per day.

Mares (late pregnancy and lactation) and stallions (hard work): feed 800g-1.2kg/100kg bodyweight per day.

Do not exceed 1.2kg/100kg bodyweight per day in total. Divide into at least 2-3 meals per day.

Ensure a minimum intake of 2kg/100kg bodyweight of forage per day.

Fresh drinking water must be available at all times. For use with target species only.
